

The Otoe County Board of Commissioners convened as the Board of Equalization at 8:25a.m. on Tuesday, April 12, 2022, in the County Courtroom of the Courthouse in Nebraska City; then convened in regular session at 8:30 a.m. Minutes of the previous meeting were not read as each Board Member was furnished with copies of the same. Members present were Jerad Sornson, Rick Freshman, and Dan Crownover. The following motions were passed by majority vote: to approve tax list corrections as presented; to approve the update of Resolution #3-15-22-8 to #3-29-22-8; to approve a Class C liquor license application for Flower Mound Ranch, LLC; to approve a permit to N.C. Utilities for land application of sludge from municipal waste treatment facilities; to approve a permit to City of Omaha (Papillion Creek WWTP/Missouri River WWTP) for land application of sludge from municipal waste treatment facilities; to approve \$20,000 for KENO grant application submitted by Nebraska City Public Schools Foundation on behalf of Nebraska City Public Schools; to approve a conservation easement submitted by Louis Stukenholtz; to adopt Resolution #4-12-22-9 for Emergency Relief Program - Emergency/Permanent Repairs.
