

The Otoe County Board of Commissioners convened 8:30 a.m. on Tuesday, April 26, 2022, in the County Courtroom of the Courthouse in Nebraska City. Minutes of the previous meeting were not read as each Board Member was furnished with copies of the same. Members present were Jerad Sornson, Rick Freshman, James Parsons, Dan Crownover and James Thurman. The following motions were passed by majority vote: to approve Jim Thurman and Dan Crownover to be a subcommittee on current planning board; to approve a moratorium of up to 12 months on conditional use permits for wind energy; to approve a 2 minute recess; to approve updating KENO grant application forms and suspend grant funding until completed; to approve ARPA fund request from Rural Water #3 and obligate up to \$28,000 for generator project; to approve a subdivision plat as requested by Richard H. and Elaine P. Hauberg; to approve an interlocal agreement for 2022-2023 SE Nebraska Drug Court; to approve 2022-2023 SE Nebraska Drug Court budget; to approve the special conditions for 2023 CB Juvenile Services Aid Grant; to award a bid to KanEquip for a compact track loader for \$63,125.00.
