

Board of Equalization
April 12, 2022

At 8:25 a.m. a meeting of the Board of Equalization was called to order by Chairman Jerad Sornson. Answering present at roll call were Commissioner Sornson, Commissioner Freshman, and Commissioner Crownover. Commissioners Parsons and Thurman were absent.

Chairman Sornson informed the public in attendance that a current copy of the Open Meetings Act is posted on the south wall of the Courtroom.

Freshman made a motion, seconded by Crownover to accept the agenda as posted. There being no further discussion Chairman Sornson called for a vote. Voting aye were Sornson, Freshman, and Crownover. Nay – none. Motion carried.

Freshman made a motion, seconded by Crownover to accept the minutes from the previous meeting and not have them read as each member was furnished with a copy of same. There being no further discussion, Chairman Sornson called for a vote. Voting aye were Freshman, Crownover, and Sornson. Nay – none. Motion carried.

Christi Smallfoot, Otoe County Assessor, presented a tax list correction to the board: 1) Parcel #000989500 – add \$234.64 to tax year 2019 – homestead exemption amount was changed from 100% to 90% after income was verified by the NE Department of Revenue; 2) Parcel #002097500 – add \$607.96 to tax year 2019 - homestead exemption amount was changed from 100% to 70% after income was verified by the NE Department of Revenue; 3) Parcel #000556000 – add \$323.30 to tax year 2019 - homestead exemption amount was changed from 100% to 70% after income was verified by the NE Department of Revenue; 4) Parcel #002099000 – add \$231.60 to tax year 2019 - homestead exemption amount was changed from 100% to 80% after income was verified by the NE Department of Revenue. Crownover made a motion, seconded by Freshman, to approve the tax list correction. Voting aye were Crownover, Sornson, and Freshman. Nay – none. Motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the Board at this time, and since all items on the agenda have been disposed of, Chairman Sornson declared the meeting adjourned at 8:26 a.m.
